Detailed itinerary for joint concert (November 4)

3:30 pm Students arrive at Kailua High School Bandroom. Sign in on door.
Set up chairs in cafeteria. Take percussion and stands to cafeteria.
Set up instruments in bandroom. Take instruments to cafeteria.
Warm up and tune individually in cafeteria.

4:00 pm Joint band warm up and rehearsal in cafeteria

4:30 pm KHS Band warms up in cafeteria

5:00 pm KIS Band warms up in cafeteria

5:30 pm Dinner and expo

6:00 pm Change into concert uniform. Doors open.

6:30 pm Expo ends. Concert begins. KIS performs.

7:00 pm Switch seats with high school band. High school band performs.

7:30 pm Set up for joint band. Joint band performs.

8:00 pm End concert. Put away instruments. Take percussion and stands back to the bandroom. Stack chairs in the cafeteria.

8:30 pm Debriefing and dismissal.
Parents sign students out on Kailua High bandroom door.

Uniform

Students must be completely dressed in the uniform set from the beginning of the school year. Failure to do so may result in restriction from performing at this concert.

Boys:

- Plain, white, long or short sleeved collared shirt – no t-shirts
- Ironed black slacks
- Black socks, mid-calf length
- Solid, black covered shoes

Girls:

- Plain, white long or short sleeved collared shirt or blouse
- Ironed black slacks or solid black skirt (skirt must be mid-calf length or longer) – no leggings/tights
- Solid black shoes or black sandals – no slippers

Exceptions

Students in the Advanced Band who are unable to participate due to extenuating circumstances known to them (e.g. severe illness, family emergency) must provide a note at least one week in advance from their parents/guardians explaining the situation. Students who have 2 or more unexcused absences or tardies from rehearsals will not be permitted to perform at the concert. Students who demonstrate inappropriate behavior will not be permitted to perform at the concert at the teacher's discretion.
